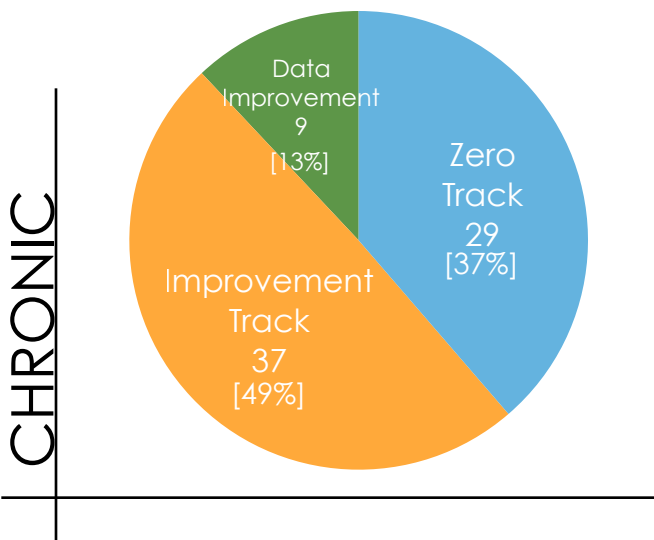

WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO GET TO ZERO?

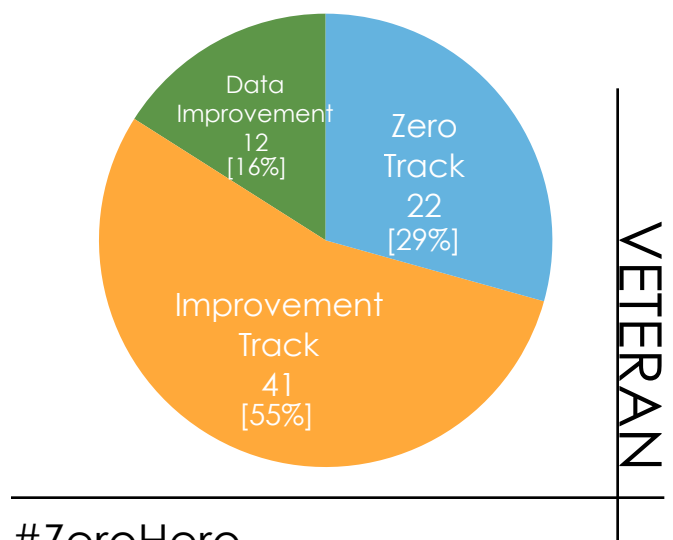
CHRONIC HOMELESSNESS: At any point in time, the number of people experiencing sheltered and unsheltered chronic homelessness, excluding veterans experiencing chronic homelessness (who are included in the group below), will be no greater than the current monthly housing placement rate for people experiencing chronic homelessness.

VETERAN HOMELESSNESS: At any point in time, the number of veterans experiencing sheltered and unsheltered homelessness will be no greater than the current monthly housing placement rate for



ZERO TRACK: These communities are meeting or exceeding their monthly housing placement targets for chronically homeless individuals and/or veterans and are on track to end either veteran homelessness by December 31, 2015 or chronic homelessness by December 31, 2016.

IMPROVEMENT TRACK: These communities are not yet meeting their monthly housing placement targets for chronically homeless individuals and/or veterans but are committed to improving in order to be on track to end veteran homelessness by December 31, 2015 and/or chronic homelessness by December 31, 2016.

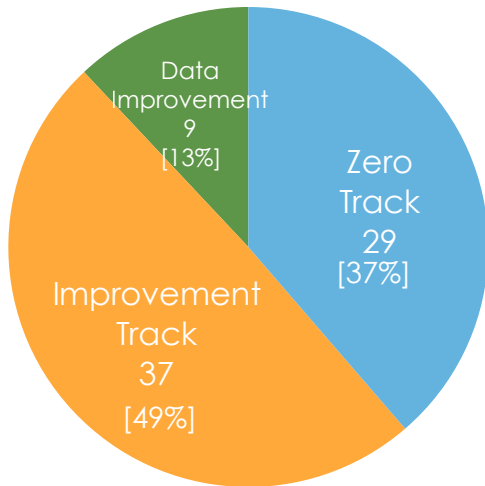

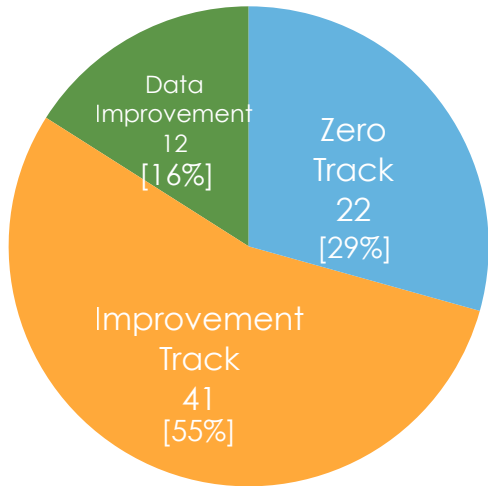
