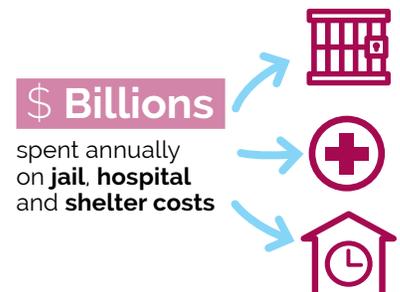

## OUR METHOD

- Helping communities **adopt proven best practices, deploy existing resources** more efficiently, and **use real-time data** to improve performance
- Implementing transparent data and performance management for **real-time improvement**
- **Engaging leadership** from the government, private and philanthropic sectors in securing new resources for communities and removing policy roadblocks
- **Connecting communities to one another** through an online platform for innovation, knowledge capture and group problem solving

## SUCCESSSES

- Nine communities so far have **ended veteran homelessness**: Rockford, IL; Arlington, VA; Montgomery County, MD; Fort Myers, FL; Gulfport, MS, Riverside, CA, Norman, OK, Bergen County, NJ, and Abilene, TX.
- Three communities have **ended chronic homelessness**: Bergen County, NJ, Lancaster, PA, and Rockford, IL
- More than **65,227 veterans** and **38,583 chronically homeless Americans housed** by participating communities since January 2015
- 64 communities have the **real time data** they need to end veteran and chronic homelessness
- 38 communities **reducing their by-name** list for (at least) one population
